About Our School

*Information/Procedures

- The school day is very involved.
- Parents should not be coming to the classroom without a prior appointment.
 - Each classroom has their own unique schedule. Please check with your child's teacher for exact times.
- Transportation changes must be made through written notice or by faxing the front office before 1:45. No exceptions.



*Attendance

- Attending school is very important to your child's education. Please arrive on time to school.
- If your child has to miss school, please write a note to explain the reason for the absence. Please sign and date the message.
- If your child more than 5 unexcused absences, the social worker will be notified.
- After 10 consecutive absences, your child will be automatically withdrawn from school and you will need to re-enroll.

*Uniforms



- Students must wear their uniform every day. A navy polo shirt with Brumby logo and khaki bottoms, skirt or jumper.
- On Jeans days students can wear a Brumby shirt & jeans for \$1.00.
- Please make sure to have your student wear comfortable shoes every day.
- Uniforms can be purchased here 7:30-9:00 or online at www.brumbyfoundation.com. If purchased online, they will be delivered directly to your child's classroom.
- Children may keep an emergency pair of clothes in the classroom. Please keep it in a sealed plastic bag with your child's first and last name.

*Breakfast & Lunch

- Please send all money in a Brumby envelope to the black box: Located in the front office
- Lunch money should be sent in a Brumby envelope or paid online.
- Breakfast is \$1.50. Lunch is \$2.35.
- School breakfast must be eaten upon arrival in the Cafeteria. (Please do not send breakfast to school with your child.)
- If parents come to eat lunch with their child, they must buy school lunch (Outside food cannot be brought into the cafeteria)
 Adult lunch is \$4.00.

*Curriculum - Reading



- Help your student learn to read by:
 - Reading with/to them at night
 - Discussing new words and vocabulary
 - Encouraging good reading habits at home.
 - Learning Rings will be sent home for the practice of sight words
 - Students need to be reading at a Level D by the end of the school year.







- We will be writing about many things such as ourselves, our families, how to make things and about the books we read.
 - Practice handwriting and holding the pencil correctly.



*Curriculum – Math



- We will be learning all about numbers and how to write them and match them together.
- We will also learn all about shapes!
- Students will need to be able to count to 100 by the end of the school year.
- An important Standard is knowing all of the numbers to twenty and being able to recognize sets for those numbers.


Students need to be able to add and subtract numbers to ten.






This year, we're using ClassDojo to build our classroom community

*Green Daily Folders

 - Folders will be sent home Monday-Friday. This is a key form of communication. Please remember to return the folder daily and clean it out weekly.
